CALL TO ORDER: Reeve Simard called the public hearing to order at 1:33 p.m.

A request to lease 256 meters of road allowance was received from West Fraser Mills Ltd. to close, lease and gate a portion of the developed road allowance win the mill site at NW 23-74-17-W5. All adjacent landowners to this 256 meters are West Fraser Mills Ltd. with the exemption of CN Railway to the north and one parcel to the south is titled to the Crown. In order to lease the road allowance, it must first be closed by a Road Closure bylaw and approved by Alberta Transportation.
