**CALL TO ORDER:** Reeve Mathews called the public hearing to order at 1:36 p.m.

An application was received from Dale Giroux to amend the Land Use Bylaw to add "Industrial Camp" as a discretionary use in the Agriculture District. An industrial camp is neither permitted nor discretionary in the Agriculture District. To legally allow the camp to remain on the parcel, a land use bylaw amendment is required. Administration is recommending the industrial camp be added as a Discretionary Use within the Agriculture District. As a discretionary use, the development authority is not bound to an approval and can add appropriate conditions in consideration of the land and location in the county.

The definition of a storage facility was also included in the Land Use Bylaw and that the use be included as discretionary use within certain land use districts.

The public hearing was duly advertised in the March 13 and 20, 2018 issues of the South Peace News and posted on the County website and Facebook pages. The Municipal Planning Commission reviewed the application at their March 27, 2018 MPC meeting and recommended approval.

Reeve Matthews called for comments from the public. Mr. Brideau read aloud a letter of concern from Williscroft Brothers opposed to the bylaw change. No one was in attendance.
