CALL TO ORDER: Reeve Simard called the public hearing to order at 11:01a.m.

Big Lakes County has received an application from Kathleen April Isadore to redistrict Plan 112 0432, Block I, Lot I within NW 25-73-13-WS from the Agriculture (AG) District to the Commercial Recreation (CREC) District.

The applicant is proposing to open an adult wellness camp which will begin as weekend camps and could eventually extend to weeklong camps. The facilitators will focus on addiction and mental health, grief and loss, anger management, yoga and reiki. There is a dwelling and a few accessory buildings on this parcel. The registered owner has authorized Ms. Isadore to make the application.

"Recreation -Extensive" is defined in the Land Use Bylaw as uses which are located in areas to take advantage of natural physical features and to provide for non-facility oriented recreational activities such as hunting, trail riding, snowmobiling, hiking, cross-country skiing, rustic camping and similar uses in rural areas. The intention is to set up wall tents and teepees and to provide portable washrooms.

Under the Land Use Bylaw "Recreation -Extensive" is neither a permitted nor a discretionary use within the Agriculture District. The Commercial Recreation District allows for Recreation - Extensive as a permitted use. Accordingly, it is necessary to redistrict to the Commercial Recreation District in order to consider the application for development permit.

The bylaw was given first reading by Council at their regular meeting of June 12, 2019.

The public hearing was advertised in the South Peace News, County webpage and social media. All landowners within the IDP area received notice by mail.

Reeve Simard called for comments from the public.

Claude Boulanger from Joussard expressed his concerns regarding the land use bylaw amendment if the proposed development was required to utilize Range Road 133.

The public hearing was closed at 11:07a.m.
