6.19.8. A fence or natural screen planting may be required for a storage facility at the discretion of the Development Authority. (Bylaw 01-2018)

The MPC felt that limiting the height of a front yard fence to 3.0 feet was restrictive and a higher fence may increase the safety of pets and children. It was also noted that there is an inconsistency between fence heights allowed on lake front lots compared to internal hamlet lots.

The MPC recommended that;

- 1. Section 6.19.4 Fences and Screening be amended to read "In front yards, no fence shall be higher than 1.8 meters (6.0 feet).";
- 2. Section 6.19.5 be deleted;
- 3. Section 6.19.7 be deleted.

The bylaw was given first reading by Council at their regular meeting of July 8, 2020.

The public hearing was advertised in the County's August resident newsletter and posted to the County website and Facebook page. Copies were also posted on the bulletin board of the County Administration office and at each hamlet post office.

The MPC passed a motion at its July 22, 2020 meeting in support of the proposed amendment.
