Policy Statement

To provide direction on the installation of informational signs.

Policy

Procedure / Responsibility


1. Requests for installation of different types of informational signs will require the approval of the Public Works Department. Council will be the body for appeals. The following are examples. Responsibility for the installation costs is also outlined:

<u>Type</u>	<u>Installation Cost</u>
Children Playing	Municipal District
Hidden Approach	Municipal District
Wildlife Crossing	Municipal District
Stock Crossing	Applicant
Stock at Large	Municipal District/Applicant
School Bus	Municipal District
Logging Trucks	Municipal District/Applicant

2. If a sign is considered to be to the benefit of the entire community (such as a "Children Playing" sign at a ball diamond), costs will be borne by the Municipal District.
3. Requests for signs will only be considered on municipal public roads. The Municipality will make all installations.
4. The Municipality will encourage any new requests for stock crossing signs to use a portable sign instead.
5. All maintenance costs for permanent signs are to be covered by the Municipality.
6. The Public Works Superintendent is hereby authorized to remove any signs no longer required. The Public Works Superintendent will inform Council of any sign removal at the next regular meeting of Council.
