2021 TAXES

Property Assessment and Tax Notices will mailed out in month of May 2021. Property Taxes are due and payable on or before Wednesday, June 30, 2021. If you don't receive your property tax notice by the end of May 2021 or if your address has changes, please contact our office at 780-523-5955.

Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP)

FARM SAFETY

It's that time of year again! Farmers will begin seeding in the next few weeks and you may be sharing the road with some large farm equipment. According to the Canadian Agricultural Injury Surveillance program, 13 per cent of farm-related fatalities across Canada are traffic related, and most of these involve tractors.

Farmers, please ensure all warning flashers and lights are clean, visible, and working properly. Motorists, please be patient and keep at least 50 feet away from the equipment so that the operator can see you.
