### POLICY STATEMENT

To minimize the inconvenience and possible added deterioration of road conditions, on the main haul routes, to County gravel pits or stock pile sites.

### POLICY

#### **PROCEDURE / RESPONSIBILITY**

The following procedures are put in place to minimize the inconvenience associated with the compressed traffic on these unique portions of road.

1. The Public Works Department shall ensure that a water truck is available to dampen down, or calcium these portions of road prior to commencement of hauling and during the hauling procedure when conditions demand dust control.
2. The haul route will be maintained by a grader on an as need basis and shall be restored to a reasonable condition at the completion of every work day.
3. Scheduled school bus times and routes shall be monitored to ensure that dust control and surface conditions are in as safe and as reasonable condition as possible during these scheduled school bus times.
4. At the completion of the regular gravel haul program from a particular site, the main haul portion shall be graveled as required and returned to a condition as close as possible to that of which existed prior to the commencement of the haul program.
