### Policy Statement

Big Lakes County recognizes the importance of dust control in the Hamlets for public safety and comfort. It is further acknowledged that dust control on Hamlet roads designated as "full use" as defined in this policy will improve the quality of life in the Hamlets. As such, the County has established this policy to provide community well being and safety.

### Policy

#### Definitions:

"**Hamlet**" shall mean any community so designated pursuant to section 59 of the Municipal Government Act.

"**Full Use Roads**" shall mean two way roads with a minimum of 2 full lane exits and a minimum residential density of eight (8) residences/kilometer.

"**Dust Control**" shall mean the application of dust control product to Big Lakes County standards.

#### General Provisions:

1. The County will maintain dust control on all Full Use Roads within a Hamlet.
2. Upon designating a road within a Hamlet as Full Use Road, the County shall, as soon as practicable, prepare the road structure for application of dust control.
3. All applications of dust control shall be done in accordance with industry standards.
4. As required, the Full Use Road will be eligible for one re-application of dust control per year. This one re-application will only be applied as needed and as budget

allows.


5. The C.A.O. shall ensure that the annual budget presented to Council for approval includes sufficient funds to undertake work required by this policy.
