#### Winter Snow Removal Reminder

#### **Public Notice Property Inspections**

Compass Assessment Consultants Inc. will be conducting inspections at select properties throughout the County boundaries from December 13 to December 17, 2021.

Properties to be inspected are those which a development permit has been applied for, or a known change has occurred.

Our inspections are broken into two categories: Rotational and Annual. Rotational inspections are maintenance inspections. This ensures the information on file is up to date and the assessments are accurate. Much like a tune-up for a car, we are reviewing properties to ensure any changes that have occurred are noted so that the assessments can keep running smoothly. By doing these inspections we ensure precision and equity in how properties are treated.

Annual inspections are done close to year end at properties where known changes have occurred. Legislative timelines require the assessment to reflect the condition of a property as of December 31. Doing this round of inspections, again, allows for accurate data collection as close as possible to the condition date. Often these are properties that have taken out development permits, or ongoing construction from the year(s) prior. Once the development is completed the properties fall back into the regular rotational inspection cycle in order to maintain them.

Both types of inspections are essential to the County's assessment roll. These inspections deliver an assessment to the municipality that is accurate and reliable. Further, it also ensures equity to the rate payers.

County assessors will be wearing photo identification badges. If residents are not home, assessors may leave a door hangar with information to contact Compass Assessment Consultants Inc. if there are questions about the development.
