

# Birding Spots around Big Lakes County

- ★ 1 Lesser Slave Lake: with its vast size, search out some of the shelter coves for waterfowl watching. You can spot Pelicans, Western Grebes, Common Goldeneyes, Merganzers, as well as Ospreys and Bald Eagles along the shore line.
- ★ 2 Faust: Great Blue Herons can be spotted fishing along the shoreline.
- ★ 3 Buffalo Bay: Great waterfowl watching in the sheltered wetlands of the bay especially in the early spring before the ices comes off the Lesser Slave Lake. As well as a diverse range of waterfowl, keep an eye out for Swans during early spring migration.
- ★ 4 Hilliard's Bay Provincial Park: Check out the extensive trail system that takes you through diverse boreal forest habitats.
- ★ 5 Winagami Lake Provincial Park: Explore the trails through the mixed wood boreal forest for the chance to spot a wide range of songbirds. You will also have a good chance on seeing waterfowl like the Pintail, Mallard, Gadwall, and Shoveller out on the lake.
