Pest Inspections

Annual Pest Inspections will commence July 4th until August 31, 2022. Surveys conducted include: Blackleg, Clubroot, and Grasshopper. During these surveys, Agricultural Services Staff will be accessing privately held land during reasonable hours, as per the Agricultural Pests Act, Section 17(2) and (3). All inspectors will be in marked Big Lakes County vehicles and will present identification upon request. We ask for your cooperation during these inspections. Property Inspections

Compass Assessment Consultants Inc. will be conducting property inspections in selected areas within the County from Monday, July 11, 2022, through to Friday July 15, 2022.

Property re-inspections are a standard policy put in place by the Provincial Government that requires all Alberta Municipalities to perform ongoing re-inspections and complete overall inspections of all properties in a five-year term. Re-inspections are maintenance inspections that ensure the information on file is up to date and the assessments are accurate. By doing these inspections we ensure precision and equity in how properties are treated.

National Drowning Prevention Week

Big Lakes County Council has dedicated the third week in July as National Drowning Prevention Week in Big Lakes County. July sees the peak of water-related incidents each year, but who is at risk?

- Over 400 Canadians drown in preventable water-related incidents annually
- A 100% of drownings in children under 5 years of age is due to a lack of supervision
- > 73% of drowning victims are male
- Not wearing a life jacket was a factor in 85% of boating deaths in Alberta

Lesser Slave Lake is the largest recreational fishery in Alberta, and fishing off the Grouard channel is enjoyed by tourists and locals alike! For your comfort, Big Lakes County has provided portable toilets for those fishing off the bridge into the Grouard Channel. Please be respectful and help keep this service clean.
