The 2022 Tax Season is Here

Property Assessment and Tax Notices were mailed out on April 29, 2022. Property taxes are due and payable on or before Thursday, June 30, 2022. Please contact our Tax and Assessment Clerk if:

- your address has changed,
- you have bought property in the last four months, or
- you do not recieve your tax notice by the end of May 2022.

Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP)

The Big Lakes County TIPPs program allows you to pay your property taxes on a monthly basis instead of one payment in June. TIPP makes budgeting easier and eliminates the risk of late payment penalties. Call our Tax and Assessment Clerk at 780 523 5955 for more information.

Spray Exemption Program

The Spray Exemption Program allows ratepayers to take control of weed management in municipal ditches adjacent to their property. Landowners are invited to participate if they would prefer to control the vegetation in the ditches surrounding their land by themselves. Existing agreements roll over into the next year. Enrollment for new plots of land are due May 13, 2022. Call our Director of Community & Protective Services for more information.

RV Parking Space Permit

An approved development permit is required for the parking or storage of any recreational vehicle on a developed or undeveloped residential lot in a Hamlet Residential District, Hamlet Estate Residential District, or Hamlet Mixed Use District. The number of RVs allowed per lot is two (2) provided that the maximum lot coverage is not exceeded. For additional information or to obtain a development permit application, contact the Planning & Development department.

Notice of Public Hearing

Council is considering an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to include "Liquor Sales" as a discretionary use under the Commercial Recreation, Hamlet Commercial, and Highway Commercial land use districts. A public hearing for Bylaw 10-2022 is scheduled for 1:30 p.m. on May 25, 2022 in Council Chambers of the County Administration Building. Transfer Station summer hours - April 1 - September 30

Big Lakes County Transfer Stations are open Wednesday & Sunday from 10 am to 7 pm.

The Regional Landfill is open Monday, Thursday & Saturday from 10am to 5pm.

Over the past several weeks, Big Lakes County has experienced an increase in vandalism at the Regional Landfill and our transfer stations. We ask that you please be respectful to staff at our transfer stations and report any suspicious activity you witness.

If caught illegally dumping waste, residents can face fines. If you witness someone dumping illegally, write down as much information as you can and report it to Big Lakes County.
