While the County's current financial picture is predicting a surplus of approximately \$2.319M, this is directly attributed to several factors, including:

- 1) Higher than anticipated revenue from land sales,
- 2) Projects that were either cancelled, or not completed in 2022, and $\,$
- 3) Unanticipated grant payments from other levels of government.
