# Big Lakes County Department Highlights

# Tips to Keep Water Pipes from Freezing

**Tip #1: Keep the Heat On** - Heat can help prevent pipes from freezing, and if pipes freeze and burst, it can cause a lot of water damage to the property and your possessions.

**Tip #2: Allow Faucet to Drip -** This will relieve pressure in the system.

**Tip #3: Keep Interior Doors Open -** When the temperatures drop, it is a good idea to keep these cabinet doors open so that the heat from the rest of the house can keep the pipes warm. Keep all interior doors open so that the heat can flow throughout the home.

Tip #4: Seal Up Cracks and Holes - Caulk any holes or cracks near the pipes. This should be done on both interior and exterior walls. Doing so can help keep the warm air in.

**Tip #5: Apply Heating Tape** - For pipes that are easily accessible, electrical heating tape may be an option to keep them from freezing.

**Tip #6: Add Extra Insulation** - Pipes that are located in areas that do not have proper insulation, such as basements or attics, may need extra insulation to keep from freezing.

#### 2022 Tax Penalties

If you still need to pay your property taxes, please pay them before January 31, 2023! A 14.5% penalty will be issued on February 1, 2023, for any balances still owing.

If you would like to sign up for our Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) it is not too late. TIPP allows you to pay your property taxes on a monthly basis instead of one payment in June.
