Christmas Hamper

Big Lakes County provides Christmas hampers to some of our low-income residents. Hampers include fixings for a turkey dinner, cereal for breakfast, and a wrapped toy for children under 16. If you would like to apply for a hamper, please make an appointment with an FCSS worker in your community. **The application deadline is Friday, December 8.** Monetary donations will receive a tax receipt. County Assessors

Compass Assessment Consultants Inc. is scheduled to perform property inspections throughout the entire county to review permits and documented changes within the area. This process will take place from Monday, December 11, 2023, through to Friday, December 15, 2023, and involves physical inspection of properties. Upon arriving at the property, their initial step is to attempt to contact the owner or occupant to announce their presence by knocking on the door. In event the resident is not available, they proceed with an exterior inspection, permissible under s.294 of the Municipal Government Act. If assessors have any questions, they leave a door hanger containing contact information (1-800-251-9711). It is important to note that county assessors will consistently display photo identification badges.

Firefighter of the Month - Claude Smith


