HOME SUPPORT

SUBSIDY PROGRAM

Big Lakes FCSS is now offering a subsidized home support program! This means that approved applicants can hire a housekeeper of their choosing and have some of the cost reimbursed by FCSS.

There are restrictions, and to be eligible you must fall into one of the following categories:

- New parent (up to 8 weeks post-partum)
- Short-term illness/injury/surgery recovery based on doctor's recommendation (doctor's note required)
 55 years of age or older

Ongoing disability - physical or intellectual (doctor's note required)

Uncashed cheques from the Canada Revenue Agency

The Canada Revenue Agency is mailing out letters to select recipients who have used Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVTIP) clinics in the past, regarding uncashed cheques. If you received a letter, please follow the directions provided.

Individuals and their representatives can view their uncashed cheques in CRA My Account.

CRA cheques never expire or become stale-dated. You can cash your CRA cheque at any financial institution in Canada. There is no charge to cash your CRA cheque.

Sleep Hygiene: what is it and why do you need it?

Sleep profoundly impacts our physical, mental, and emotional well-being, and is just as vital to our health as a balanced diet and exercise.

- Be mindful of your diet Avoid heavy or spicy meals, caffeine, and alcohol close to bedtime, as they can interfere with your sleep.
- Exercise regularly Engaging in physical activity during the day can help you sleep better at night. However, try to finish exercising at least a few hours before bedtime.

GROUARD CEMETERY COMMITTEE

December 31st marks the 150th anniversary of the Grouard Cemetery for which a monument will be installed. While it has been decided that the monument will not be ordered until the fall of 2024, to allow us more time to finalize the details of those buried there, it is the cutoff date for the names going on the monument. This means that anyone that has passed away **prior** to December 31, 2023 will have their name on the monument, assuming we have their name and details to work with. This means that ashes/cremains can be buried in 2024 and included on the monument if the person passed prior to December 31, 2023.

The information we need includes:

- Birthdate and location
- Passing date and location
- Names of spouse(s) and parents, and whether they are also in the cemetery
- Photos and funeral cards

All this information will be added to the list that Grouard Seniors maintains but, more importantly, it will be added to the <u>FindAGrave.com</u> website so future generations can find information about their ancestors.
