Emergency Preparedness Tips

Knowing your rural address is extremely important in the case of an emergency, especially if you are evacuated. You will be asked for this information when you register at a reception centre.

If you find it difficult to remember, take a picture of your blue sign outside your house and store it on your phone or on a USB drive that you carry with you. That way you have it when you need it!

If other first responders are ever dispatched to your home, being able to tell them your rural address (blue sign address) could save your life!



The purpose of proposed Bylaw No. 21-2023 is to re-district Plan 242 _____, Block 1, Lot 1 within SW 32-72-09-W5 south of the Hamlet of Kinuso from the Agriculture (AG) District to Highway Commercial (HWC) District as shown on the accompanying sketch:

The Cemetery Committee held two more small events at the end of January to get more people involved in confirming the names and info about those buried in the cemetery. Of the nearly 1500 names we have:

- Over 200 still need clarification of some details (name spelling or who they are)
- 36 have not been added to FindaAGrave.com due to lack of detail.

Time is starting to run out on our ability to get all the names on the list prior to ordering the monument.

We want to thank the Calahasen family for \$1000 in donations for the monument. This donation was based on \$50/family member in the cemetery.

We are applying for funding from the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund, described as "A Catholic Commitment to Healing and Reconciliation", a Diocesan or Regional Application for Project Funding.

With so many ancestors and descendants having the same name it appears that the monument will also need to include dates (DOB, DOD) so descendants can find their loved ones more readily.
