I/We, the undersigned acknowledge and accept the following terms and conditions related to this service:


- 1. Dust suppression strips are to be applied to the identified road by Big Lakes County Operations Department upon completion of the appropriate application by the resident/landowner and pre-payment of the calculated fee. Scheduling of the work shall be subject to regular dust suppression program priorities and in combination with other requests due to cost effectiveness.
- 2. Dust suppression strips shall be a minimum length of 150 m of roadway surface.
- 3. **Big Lakes County does not guarantee the effectiveness of the dust control agent. Once the agent has been applied no refunds of the application fee will be made.** All efforts will be made to increase the longevity of the treated area; however, if the need arises the said portion of treated roadway will be graded to minimize hazards for vehicular traffic.
- 4. A maximum of two applications of the dust control product can be obtained per location per year via this program. Properties that are bordered by two roads may apply for an additional 150m of dust control for the second road at the same rate. Second applications of the product, if provided later in the year, shall be at the same location, if provided, shall be at the same location as the first application
- 5. Second applications of dust control product will be applied only if the Executive Director of Operations deems there to be sufficient demand to make acquisition of additional dust control product feasible.
