STAY AWAY FROM CYANOBACTERIA (BLUE-GREEN ALGAE)

algae) is a type of bacteria found in many pets? lakes, ponds, and reservoirs. Cyanobacteria Lakes contaminated with cyanobacteria can be can multiply a lot in the summer, causing extensive growths called blooms. The blooms and deaths of livestock and wildlife have been cause scum on the surface of water and can linked to animals drinking water containing be blue-green or greenish-brown and often cyanobacteria. Keep animals away from smell musty or grassy.

Some bloom-forming types of cyanobacteria produce toxins. When toxic blooms die and decay, toxic chemicals may be released into the water. Some toxins can be in the water at low levels for many months after a bloom forms. Some blooms are so bad that they cause livestock deaths. Some blooms don't What about watering my vegetable garden? contain toxins, but you can't tell if a bloom is harmful or not from how it looks. If you see a bloom, always take precautions as if it is toxic.

How does cvanobacteria affect human health?

Children might be more at risk for getting sick from cyanobacteria because they often spend more time in the water and may swallow contaminated water by accident.

If you have **contact** (e.g., swimming, boating) with water containing cyanobacteria, you may experience:

- skin irritation and rash
- sore throat
- sore, red eyes
- swelling of the lips
- hay fever symptoms (e.g., stuffy nose)

If you drink water containing cyanobacteria, you may experience:

- headache
- diarrhea
- weakness
- liver damage
- fever (temperature more than 38.5°C or 101.3°F)
- nausea and vomiting
- muscle and joint pain
- stomach cramps

Treat all cyanobacteria blooms with caution. Call Health Link at 811 if you have been in contact with water that has a cyanobacteria bloom and are having symptoms.

Cyanobacteria (also referred to as blue-green How does cyanobacteria affect livestock and

deadly if toxins are present. Some illnesses natural water sources that contain cyanobacteria blooms because animals aren't concerned about how water looks or smells before they drink it. Don't let animals eat whole fish or trimmings (any waste from filleting a fish including the head, bones, intestines, or skin) from affected lakes.


Don't use water with cyanobacteria to water edible plants (especially plants with edible parts exposed to the ground surface, such as cabbage, lettuce, tomatoes, and other salad vegetables). It is not known if fruits and vegetables absorb toxins from contaminated water.

Is it safe to cook with water that might contain cyanobacteria?

Boiling water doesn't remove cyanobacteria toxins. Don't cook with water that might contain cyanobacteria.

What else do I need to think about?

- Treat any cyanobacteria bloom as if it is contaminated.
- Don't swim or wade in water with scum on the surface.
- Don't drink water if it might be contaminated with cyanobacteria.
- Have another source of drinking water for pets and livestock.
- If you see a bloom or have questions about cyanobacteria, call Environmental Public Health 1-833-476-4743.
- Call Health Link at 811 if you have been in contact with contaminated water and have any of the symptoms listed above.
- Call a vet if your pet has been in contact with contaminated water.

GROUARD CEMETERY COMMITTEE

Now that summer has arrived, we have tons of work to do. There are some plot numbers that need to be assigned, new plots to lay out (future burials), and general cleanup of tasks we didn't get to last fall.

We had amazing weather for the mini gatherings we held in conjunction with the Treaty 8 events. Many were thankful for the shade of our canopy tents while others basked in the sunshine of the first week of summer. We had a handful of people stop by and chat with us and we walked around to gather information with them. Thanks to these walk-abouts we have the names for 4 or 5 more of the visible but unidentified graves. This alone makes the gatherings a success.

We are still progressing with updates to our list but are glad to say that we only have about 150 names that need some clarification (name spelling or dates). We will post these over the coming weeks to see if we can get some insight. As for visible but unidentified graves we sill have about 49, but that is a huge difference from a year ago (roughly half as many). Overall, our updates are going well but we are drawing ever closer to the deadline of September 30th.

The concrete base for the monument is not something we will be able to do ourselves due to the sheer size of it. We now have a quote for this installation as well which makes our overall expense, including the monument and foundation, of around \$70,000. As yet we have not heard back from the church regarding a request for funding to assist in the purchase of the monument. Fundraising will continue until we order the monument at the end of September.

<u>Just a reminder, once we order the monument names will not be added so we need our list finalized by the end of September.</u>

We are continuing to do plot layout for future burials and will notify everyone of these activities on the Grouard Community Facebook page.

PART-TIME ICE MAKER for the 2024-2025 curling season. Starting late September/early October, the accredited Ice Technician will work closely with the Curling Committee to ensure that the Curling Season runs as smoothly and effectively as possible. Duties and responsibilities include:

- Install and make ready the ice surface of the three sheets of ice and, upon completion of the season, to remove the ice, boards, benches etc. and clean the rink to the satisfaction of the Board of Directors and by the date determined by them.
- Maintain ice surface and ensure that the ice is in the best playing condition possible, performing regular ice maintenance, includes cleaning and pebbling of surface for all draws, bonspiels, and curling rentals.
- 3. Monitoring and tuning the ice plant and ice making equipment as necessary, and to respond promptly to emergency situations regarding the ice plant and rink in general.
- 4. Maintain the ice cleaning equipment (i.e., mops, brooms, hand scrapers, etc.), the walkways around the curling sheets etc., in a clean and unobstructed condition for the safety of all curlers.
- 5. The ice technician is to be available to open, close and to physically remain in the curling rink for all curling related activities such as Regular League Play, After-School Curling, Bonspiels and Ice Rentals.
