I release the County, its' Councillors, officers, employees, agents and representatives (the "Releasees") from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense that I may suffer or that my successors or assigns may suffer as a result of anything done that may be related to the removal or destruction of prohibited noxious or noxious weeds, due to any cause whatsoever, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES.

I agree to hold harmless and indemnify the Releasees from any and all liability for any property damage, personal injury to any third party or other financial loss or expense, including legal expenses and costs (on a solicitor and his own client basis), which may be caused by the removal or destruction of prohibited noxious and noxious weeds.
